The Balaton Group

A global network for collaboration on systems and sustainability—founded in 1982



Low Carbon Societies Network



- Network of CSOs/NGOs and researchers
- 128 registered members/users in database
- Contact database, collect information, seminars, newsletters, shall develop exchanges, cooperation and disseminate information from ENCI project
- Supported by EU 2009-2011
- Secr. in Denmark (INFORSE-Europe)

International Research Network for Low Carbon Societies [LCS-RNet]

Global research network aiming for building "Low Carbon Societies"

- Network of research institutions and gov. agencies
- 15 members (institutions)
- Annual meetings, stakeholder dialogues, information collection
- Started by G8 environment ministers' process
- Secr. in Japan



- Network of students, researchers, gov. agency persons, NGO persons and others using LEAP
- About 3000 registered in database, 10-20% active
- Training, newsletter, information sharing, lists, LEAP used in national reports to UNFCCC
- Also focus on developing countries
- Secr. in USA (SEI Boston)



The Balaton Group

A global network for collaboration on systems and sustainability—founded in 1982

- Group of researchers in scenarios, system dynamics, sustainable development, etc. from Limits to Growth
- 400 have participated, about 80 each year
- Started in 1982
- Coordinated from USA



INTERNATIONAL CENTRE FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT
OF ENERGY, WATER AND ENVIRONMENT SYSTEMS

- Group of researchers in scenarios and sustainable development
- 183 participants, mainly researchers
- Organise Dubrovnik Conferences every second year, since 2002
- Temporary seat in Zagreb



One Planet Economy Network:

- EU project to develop footprint and reduction scenarios for all EU countries
- 8 project partners (institutions, NGOs), about 25 informal network members to follow the project
- Supported by EU 2010-2012



INFORSE Sustainable Energy Visions:

- To engage and support NGOs into sustainable energy scenarios and strategies
- Development of national scenarios and visions
- Scenarios for 10 countries
- Seminars, exchanges, outreach
